	 (b) Criteria: Continuous assessment is measured by the daily assessment on student performance by providing total nursing care to individuals, families and communities in accordance to their clinical goals (course learning outcomes). (C) Weights: Continuous Assessment 100% Presence is compulsory for all students, absences of up to 15% are replenished, and beyond this percentage the student fails the entire course.
