The second part examines the student's depth of knowledge in the area of his research at the graduate course level. The duration for each part of the exam is from 1½ to 2½ hours The content of the PhD Qualifying Exam is decided by the Research Advisory Committee of the student. The student must be informed in writing about the form of the qualifying exam and the reading material, at least ten weeks before the date of the qualifying exam.
