#### **Job Description**

The Instructional Designer will play support innovative teaching and learning practices across the University. The successful candidate will collaborate with faculty and staff to design, develop, and implement high-quality blended and online courses and learning experiences, aligned with CIET's mission to promote pedagogical excellence and digital innovation.

#### **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Support the design, development, and evaluation of blended, online, and technology-enhanced learning environments.
- Collaborate with faculty in applying sound pedagogical and instructional design principles to develop engaging, inclusive, and student-centered learning materials.
- Guide academic staff in the integration of digital tools and educational technologies (e.g., Moodle, H5P, SCORM, generative AI tools) into their courses.
- Assist in the development of interactive and multimedia-based learning resources using authoring tools and learning design methodologies.
- Contribute to faculty professional development by organizing training workshops, resources, and one-on-one consultations on instructional design and innovative pedagogies.
- Support CIET's initiatives, projects, and strategic goals to foster excellence in teaching, learning, and assessment.

#### **The successful candidate should have**

- University degree in Education, Educational Technology, Instructional Design, Computer Science, Learning Sciences, Curriculum and Instruction, Instructional/Educational Psychology, Multimedia Design for Education, or a related field.
- Advanced knowledge and experience in instructional design, online pedagogy, and the use of learning management systems (preferably Moodle).
- Experience in designing and developing learning resources and activities for blended, and online education contexts.

- Familiarity with authoring tools and digital media technologies (e.g., H5P, Articulate, Captivate, SCORM, multimedia production software).
- Experience in the application of AI tools in education.
- Strong understanding of pedagogy, learning theories, and best practices in technology-enhanced learning.
- Ability to collaborate effectively with faculty, staff, and interdisciplinary teams.
- Excellent organizational and communication skills, with the ability to work under tight and demanding deadlines.

**The following additional qualifications are also desirable but not a requirement**

- Experience in developing simulations, serious games, or immersive learning applications (AR/VR).
- Knowledge of Universal Design for Learning (UDL) principles and accessibility standards.
