

EMERGENCY PLAN IN CASE OF EARTHQUAKE

(1) DURING THE EARTHQUAKE

IT IS IMPORTANT TO REMAIN CALM!!!

- **If you are outside** the University Building, remain there but keep away from buildings, walls, electric poles and anything that may fall and injure you.
- **If you are inside** the University building, remain there. Attempting to go outside puts you at greater risk of injury.



1. Seek shelter under a desk, sturdy table or a similar object.



2. Do not stand next to window, cabinets, shelves, or objects that could break or fall and cause injury.



3. Assist disabled, helpless or sick individuals.

EMERGENCY PLAN IN CASE OF EARTHQUAKE

(2) AFTER THE EARTHQUAKE

IT IS IMPORTANT TO REMAIN CALM!!!



1. During the evacuation activate the alarm system by pressing the glass on the nearest Call point (red box).



2. Evacuate the building through the nearest **Emergency Exit** following the guidance of Teaching staff (for those in Teaching-rooms/laboratories), Emergency Floor Coordinators or other University Staff members based on your location.
3. Do not use the elevator.

**ASSEMBLY
POINT**

4. Safely proceed to designated **Assembly Area.** (Parking area)



5. If you need assistance, ask University Staff members to help you reach a safe area.



6. DO NOT stop to collect your personal belongings.
7. Stay outside and return to the building half an hour after the last earthquake tremor and/or until given permission.
