
Welcome to Frederick University and congratulations on becoming a new member of our vibrant student community.

During the New Student Orientation Day you will:


Learn about student services and important information regarding your studies.

Course Registration and Start of the Semester

Every semester, before the beginning of classes, you will need to meet with your Academic Advisor in order to register to your semester courses. For Spring 2022 you will be able to register to your courses during the New Students Orientation Day that will take place on February 11.

In order to be able to attend classes you need to have:

Paid the tuition fees of Spring 2022 semester. Your student account is now activated!
Received through SMS on your mobile phone your student credentials (username & password). By using your student credentials, you can access all University's computing and information systems services.
Met with your Academic Advisor during Orientation Day in order to register to your courses.
Used your account credentials to access the Student Platform - Extranet in order to finalise your course registration and review your timetable https://extranet.frederick.ac.cy
Activated your Student Email Account - Webmail. Use your student credentials in and log in https://webmail.frederick.ac.cy
Used your account credentials to access the E-learn Platform and the content of my semester courses. https://learn.frederick.ac.cy
Completed (during the first two weeks of the semester) the Student Online Orientation Program and been informed about the use of the information systems services, the rules, regulations and procedures that pertain to your studies, your rights and responsibilities as members of the academic community, as well as about all the student support services designed especially for our students.
