

## The Michael Frederickou Sustainable Development Goals Actions Awards

A series of awards will be given to faculty, researchers, staff, students, and graduates who promote the Sustainable Development Goals and, through their work, inspire others to create change.

## The University will award:

- practices or activities from faculty, research, staff, students and graduates that show significant impact with respect to SDGs or
- outstanding individuals (faculty, research, staff, students and graduates) who are demonstrating that it is up to us to inspire and enact change.

## Criteria

Submissions should demonstrate how the nominee's activities contribute to at least one of the following:

- **Mobilizer:** Mobilize others to take action for the SDGs.
- Inspirer: Inspire a shift in behaviour for the SDGs.
- **Connector:** Connect people and/or diverse partners, bridging the gap between citizens and institutions, to increase progress on the SDGs.
- Innovator / Doer: Have implemented an innovation/idea or have carried out a small project or made efforts towards achieving one or more SDGs.

Multiple awards may be given for actions relating to different SDGs.

## **Procedure**

Nominations are accepted in any of the following ways:

- **1. Self-Nomination.** Interested applicants should apply by completing the <u>Application Form</u> by **Sunday**, **June 1**<sup>st</sup>, **2025**
- **2. Nominated by any member** of University Community by completing the Nomination Form by Sunday, May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2025
