



The Michael Frederickou Sustainable Development Goals Actions Awards

A series of awards will be given to faculty, researchers, staff, students, and graduates who promote the Sustainable Development Goals and, through their work, inspire others to create change.

The University will award:

- practices or activities from faculty, research, staff, students and graduates that show significant impact with respect to SDGs or
- outstanding individuals (faculty, research, staff, students and graduates) who are demonstrating that it is up to us to inspire and enact change.

Criteria

Submissions should demonstrate how the nominee's activities contribute to at least one of the following:

- **Mobilizer:** Mobilize others to take action for the SDGs.
- **Inspirer:** Inspire a shift in behaviour for the SDGs.
- **Connector:** Connect people and/or diverse partners, bridging the gap between citizens and institutions, to increase progress on the SDGs.
- **Innovator / Doer:** Have implemented an innovation/idea or have carried out a small project or made efforts towards achieving one or more SDGs.

Multiple awards may be given for actions relating to different SDGs.

Procedure

Nominations are accepted in any of the following ways:
